Dear Mr. Friedberg,

I have not received a response to my letter of 8/20/08, which regarded the recorded statements by Mr. Kevin O'Sullivan regarding your order that I be effectively banned from recourse to the DDC. That letter is attached, and an immediate response is requested.

I am also requesting the status of my complaint against Mr. Leon Friedman, which was stamped "Received" by your receptionist on August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 3:47pm. For the following reasons, I have concluded that you are whitewashing the complaint against Mr. Friedman:

- a) I have never received acknowledgment of my complaint from your office.
- b) Your predecessor, Mr. Cahill fraudulently claimed that Mr. Friedman did not practice in Manhattan and was thereby not under the jurisdiction of the First Department.
- c) Over the past three years your committee has steadfastly refused to acknowledge that Mr. Friedman is under your jurisdiction.
- d) Mr. O'Sullivan has asserted in a recorded conversation that you have ordered your staff to ignore my communications.
- e) You have failed to respond to my letter of 8/20/08, which specifically requested an explanation of Mr. O'Sullivan's recorded statements.

f) The testimony of Christine Anderson confirms that your committee has a history of systematic whitewashing of complaints against lawyers who have illicit influence over the DDC.

g) My past experience with your committee, including its dismissal of a complaint based upon nothing but a “sealed response” from the Respondent, against a meticulously documented complaint that had been vetted by your staff is demonstrative of utter dysfunction and/or corruption in your committee.

Given these circumstances, it will reflect very poorly on you and much more poorly on your superior Judge Lippman, if you continue to discriminate against me in regard to my access to the Committee and its resources, which is my Civil Right. I am again requesting an immediate clarification of your orders to your staff regarding communication with me, and an explanation of Mr. O’Sullivan’s statements as well as a report regarding the status of my complaint against Mr. Friedman. Failure to respond will be considered an affirmation of Mr. O’Sullivan’s allegations.
