Mr. Gelernter, you are SO right – including that the confirmation process is used "for quid pro quos". The reason? It is particularized and fully-documented by letters to the Senate Judiciary Committee and President Obama, dated December 17, 2014 and January 5, 2015, sent by our non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc.(CJA). The letters – copies of which we also sent to U.S. Attorney Lynch for response – are posted on our website, www.judgewatch.org, accessible via the prominent homepage link: "CJA's Citizen Opposition to Senate Confirmation of U.S. Attorney Lynch as Attorney General".

This politically-explosive story – as yet unreported – can go far in cleaning up corruption in the Justice Department and its sham Office of Professional Responsibility, over and beyond the deal-making that substitutes for a legitimate confirmation "process".

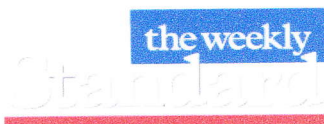

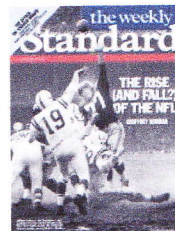

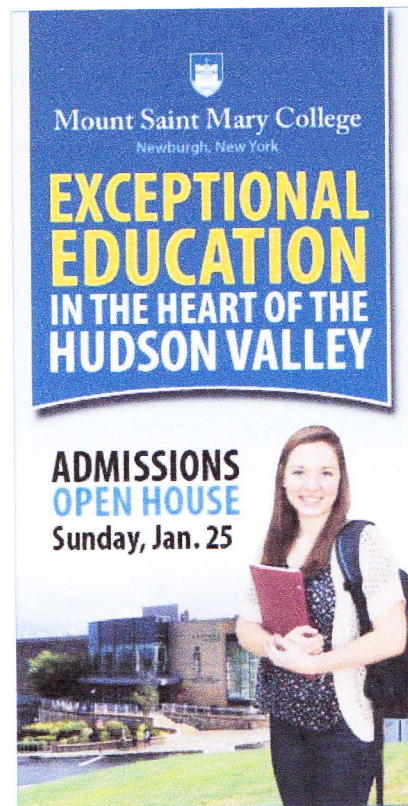
