Dear Mr. Nader:

Enclosed is a copy of CJA's July 8th letter to Michael Kramer, Editorial Director of *Brill's Content* -- a magazine which carries your endorsement on its promotional literature and website.

We do not know whether *Content* will be worthy of your endorsement. However, we know that the story proposal presented by our letter, resting on views you have long espoused, is worthy of your endorsement -- which we request.

As noted by our letter to Mr. Kramer (at p. 5), you were an indicated recipient of our October 15, 1996 submission to Project Censored, our December 2, 1996 supplement to that submission, and our February 12, 1998 letter to Mr. Sulzberger. These extensive primary source materials have meticulously chronicled years of deliberate suppression by *The New York Times* of electorally-significant stories about the dysfunction and corruption of judicial selection and discipline and its blackballing of our citizens' organization.

We very much doubt that you have even perused these materials -- or any of the others we have provided you over the past five years. However, the several pages of our enclosed letter to Mr. Kramer should suffice for your endorsement of our story proposal. Please let us at least have that.
