Update

Jonathan Lippman, deputy chief administrator of the courts for the past six years, was nominated to a Court of Claims judgeship by Governor Pataki yesterday. The State Senate is scheduled to act on his confirmation today, the last day of the legislative session. Mr. Lippman, 50, is expected to remain in his post at the Office of Court Administration with the new title deputy chief administrative judge. The Governor moved to fill three other vacancies, naming Nassau County Court Judge John Dunne to Supreme Court; Mineola attorney Frank Gulotta to Nassau County Court, and Schoharie County Court Judge Dan Lamont to the Court of Claims.
