Dear Ms. Sassower:

Enclosed is a copy of a letter to your daughter in which the time to retrieve the files she delivered to any members of the Krausman Committee has been extended to January 14, 2005. This takes into consideration her six-month sentence of incarceration which, as you said, will be over no later than December 25, 2004.

As to your question regarding which members of the committee reviewed the files your daughter dropped off, as I initially told you, I was not going to make such an inquiry but I then agreed to give this request more thought and I have.

After giving it more thought, I still decline. I would be very uncomfortable polling the 30 or so members of the committee, even if I had the time to do so, to inquire if any of them specifically considered these or any other materials. I just do not think it is my place to do so.

On the other hand, since the identities of the members of the committee are public information (published on the court's web site as part of the publication of the Final Report of the Krausman Committee), you are certainly free to make such inquiries on your own.
