Your (On-Going) Responsibility to "Champion Basic Citizen Rights—and the Vital Importance of Citizen Participation in Tederal Judicial Selection" at Issue in the "Disruption of Congress' case of United States of America v. Elena Ruth Sassower:

(1) by individually or collectively submitting a statement to the Court in advance of the June 28th sentencing;

(2) by providing legal and amicus curiae assistar ce on the appeal, including to vindicate the elementary proposition hat "a citizen's respectful request to testify at a public congressional he ring is not – and must never be deemed to be – 'disruption of Congress' by challenging the constitutionality of D.C. Code §10-503.16(b)(4), its written and as applied;

(3) by alerting your media and academic contacts to this case.

"On June 28th, I am to be sentenced to up to six months in jail and a \$500 fine. This, as a result of my wrongful conviction in April on the baseless and malicious 'disruption of Congress' charge – for which, last year, I turned to each of you for help in "championing basic citizen rights – and the vital importance of citizen action in federal judicial selection'."
