7 MS. SASSOWER: I am requesting a stay of sentence,
8 pending appeal. This case will be appealed.

9 THE COURT: Ms. Sassower, the answer is yes or no.
10 Do you accept the conditions of your probation?

11 MS. SASSOWER: No.

12 THE COURT: Very well. Then, sentence is imposed
13 as follows:

14 You are sentenced to six months incarceration.

15 You will pay, within 30 days, following your
16 incarceration, \$500 as the fine that attaches to the penalty
17 -- to the offense for which you've been convicted.

18 You will also pay, within 30 days, following your
19 incarceration, the \$250 compensation -- contribution to the
20 Victims of Violent Crimes Fund.

21 Ms. Sassower, once again, your pride has gotten in
22 the way of what could have been a beneficial circumstance for
23 you. This incarceration begins forthwith; step her back.
