RE: Our 4/27/94 and 7/11/94 letter-complaints

Dear Mr. Laghezza:

This letter confirms our two telephone conversations this week, wherein you indicated that Ms. Hafer has completed her review of one redweld--and has begun review of the second.

Although I expressed surprise and concern that we have not heard from Ms. Hafer directly, you assured me that should Ms. Hafer have any question or doubt as to the substantiating nature of the documentation we have supplied to your office, she will call us.

I again reiterate our readiness to assist Ms. Hafer in every way so as to permit her to fully verify the truth of our serious charges that justices of the Appellate Division, Second Department and their at-will appointees--aided and abetted by their counsel, the Attorney General of the State of New York--are engaged in a criminal conspiracy to subvert the court's disciplinary power for ulterior retaliatory purposes.

As discussed, I enclose a copy of the Attorney General's flimsy August 5, 1994 "Memorandum of Law" to the Court of Appeals in opposition to my mother's reargument motion, as well as my mother's Reply August 8, 1994 Reply Affidavit.

I also transmit herewith the transcripts of the four days of hearings on the February 6, 1990 Petition, referred to, inter alia, at ¶¶ 14-15 of the Jurisdictional Statement.

I would specifically draw Ms. Hafer's attention to the page references of the hearing transcripts, referred to at fn. 4 (p. 9) of my mother's August 8, 1994 Reply Affidavit.

Again, I thank you for your time and attention to this matter.
