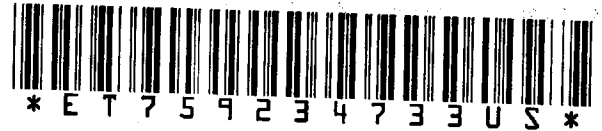

This letter is occasioned by the April 8<sup>th</sup> New York Times article "*Spitzer Said to Try to Woo Golisano Away From Fight*", reporting that it was "unclear" whether Attorney General Spitzer's recent meeting with you had "deterred" you from using your "political and financial clout to harm Mr. Spitzer's candidacy [for Governor] or otherwise influencing the race."

According to the article, you had previously met with "Kenneth Langone, a billionaire businessman who has been sued by Mr. Spitzer's office and is working to defeat him in the governor's race." This has apparently given rise to "rumors of a Golisano-Langone financial
