Dear Hezie,

Just wanted to be sure you saw that CJA's webpage for the February 6th letter <u>http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/searching-nys/2017-legislature/2-6-17-ltr-to-leadership.htm</u> posts pdfs of transmitting e-mails, reflecting my follow-up conversations with staff of indicated legislators with districts in Westchester – as, for instance, the below February 7th e-mail to Assemblyman Abinati's legislative director, which included the message:

"Please IMMEDIATELY furnish it to the Assemblyman's chief of staff & counsel, Joanne Sold – and to the Assemblyman. <u>Appropriate, responsive action is ESSENTIAL – as there</u> <u>is NO LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT by any of the 'appropriate committees'</u> -- and the <u>violations of prior budget cycles are REPEATING</u>. This MUST be a TOP PRIORITY of the <u>Commission on Government Administration – when it is statutorily-constituted, which</u> must be forthwith.

I am available to assist Assemblyman Abinanti, <u>to the max</u>." (capitalization & underlining in original).

What steps did Abinanti take to ensure that Stewart-Cousins, Flanagan, Heastie, & Kolb would make their appointments to the Commission on Governmental Administration, for which he, presumably, was expecting to collect a lulu -- & which, in any event, had a statutory function to perform?

For your convenience, attached is Legislative Law §83-c establishing the Commission on Governmental Administration (aka public management systems). See para 3, which would be the authority for lulu-collection. Identical & or/similar paragraphs appear for 4 other Legislative Law Article 5-A statutory commissions:

§83-e. Legislative commission on science and technology.

§83-f. Legislative commission on skills development and career education.

§83-i. Legislative commission on the development of rural resources.

§83-I. Legislative commission on water resource needs of New York state and Long Island.

I am available to answer your questions, to be interviewed, and, especially, to critique such responses as you get from Abinanti, Stewart-Cousins, Latimer, & other legislators.... Feel free to call any time, including at night & on the weekend. There are other pieces of the "lulu" story I'd like to alert you to, as well.
