
Dear Ms. Sassower:

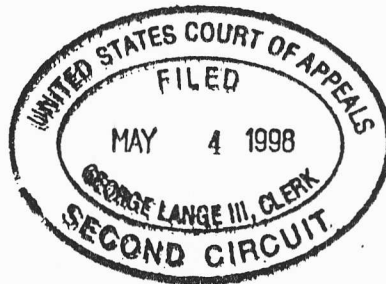
