I respectfully submit the itemized estimates of the annual financial needs of the Judiciary for General State Charges for the Fiscal Year beginning April 1, 2014. Article VII, Section 1 of the Constitution requires the submission of these estimates to the Governor and legislative leaders on or before December 1, 2013.

For the 2014-2015 Fiscal Year, the Judiciary is again submitting itemized estimates of funding for General State Charges necessary to pay the fringe benefits of judges, justices and nonjudicial employees separately from itemized estimates of the annual operating needs of the Judiciary. This presentation follows the long-standing practice of the Executive and Legislative Branches of separately presenting requests for funding of fringe benefit costs and requests for operating funds. The Judiciary will submit a single budget bill, which includes requests for funding for operating expenses and fringe benefit costs for the 2014-2015 Fiscal Year.

Major Purpose Description

This Major Purpose includes funding required for fringe benefits provided to state-paid judges and nonjudicial employees. Appropriations are required for pension contributions, Social Security and Medicare, health insurance premiums, dental, vision and life insurance for judges and management/confidential employees, and employee benefit funds. These General State Charges appropriations are included in the 2014-15 budget bill submitted by the Judiciary.

Summary of 2014-15 Funding: General State Charges

The General State Charges Major Purpose All Funds budget requirement is \$669.1 million, or an increase of \$8.5 million (1.3%) over the current year adjusted appropriation. Required amounts for payment of fringebenefits include funding for the continuation of all statutorily-required and collectively bargained benefit provisions, as follows:

Nonpersonal Service

Pension: \$270.1 million

The amount required reflects an estimated obligation of \$268.9 million, as amortized, to the New York State Employees' Retirement System, which includes the repayment of amortized amounts from prior years. This represents an increase of \$5.7 million (2.2%) over the current year's projected obligation. The funding requirement also reflects an estimated obligation of \$1.3 million to the New York City Retirement System for certain retirees who elected to remain in that retirement system.

Social Security and Medicare: \$104.7 million

The amount reflects a statutorily-mandated employer contribution rate of 7.65% applied to earnings up to \$117,000 and 1.45% on earnings exceeding \$117,000. This represents an increase of \$1.6 million (1.6%) over the current year, reflecting an increase in the Social Security wage ceiling.

Health, dental, vision & life insurance: \$270.5 million

This requirement reflects an increase of \$0.9 million (0.3%) over the 2013-14 adjusted appropriation. The requested amount reflects increases in health insurance premiums as projected by the NYS Department of Civil Service, offset by an anticipated credit provided by the federal government for employers who provide retiree prescription drug coverage. Funding is also included for retired employees' health insurance; administrative costs payable to the NYS Department of Civil Service, and funds necessary to reimburse localities for certain retirees who elected to remain in local health plans.

The amount also includes costs associated with dental, vision and life insurance coverage for judges, as well as unrepresented and managerial/confidential nonjudicial employees.

Employee Benefit Funds: \$23.9 million

The amount includes contractual obligations to employee benefit funds for eligible employees and retirees. Employees participating in these funds are generally ineligible for other judiciary dental plans and in some instances, the prescription drug reimbursement plan, thus reducing the amounts required for health and dental insurance.
