## TO: Appellate Division, Third Department Chief Motion Attorney Edward Carey

This is to request an adjournment of the return date of my order to show cause, signed by Appellate Division, Third Department Presiding Justice Elizabeth Garry on September 12, 2018 and made returnable tomorrow, September 27, 2018, so that I may have the opportunity to submit reply papers, in the event that Assistant Solicitor General Brodie does not withdraw his September 24, 2018 opposing memorandum, as is his duty to do because it is fraudulent, from beginning to end.
