This will respond to your recent communications to this Office on or about April 29, 2014 in which you requested an update as to whether we had received certain documents that you had previously suggested that a criminal investigator in our Office obtain regarding a potential crime you sought to bring to the attention of this Office. As we have previously informed you, we are not permitted under the rules and policies governing the conduct of criminal investigations to advise you or other interested member of the public on the status of those investigations, including on the question of whether we have obtained documents you believe to be relevant to an investigation. You can be assured that we take seriously and investigate thoroughly allegations of potential violations of federal criminal law, but we cannot discuss such ongoing investigations. Accordingly, we do not believe that further discussion or a meeting with you would serve any useful purpose. Please be advised that you should not expect a response from our Office to further communications from you.
