Dear Mr. Freeman:


Pursuant to §670.8(d)(1) of the Rules of the Appellate Division, Second Department, parties may stipulate to enlarge time to perfect an appeal "by up to 60 days", which is then so-ordered by the clerk.

Please advise whether you would be amenable to signing such stipulation so that the above-numbered appeals, which appellants will be consolidating and presenting by a single appeal brief, will be due on Monday, April 23, 2007, rather than on Wednesday, February 21, 2007, the due date for the first two appeals. Otherwise, I will directly apply to the clerk, who, according to the clerk's office, usually grants these applications as a matter of course.

Needless to say, appellants would reciprocate by signing a stipulation to extend your time to file your answering brief by the full "30 days" allowable, should you request same.
