Dear Ms. Sassower:

This letter responds to your correspondence dated May 24, 2017, which pursuant to FOIL, requested:

- (1) the 37 "single-purpose" appropriation bills for fiscal year 2001-2002 that the Legislature passed on August 2, 2001 and August 3, 2001, at issue in Pataki v. Assembly and Senate, 190 Misc. 2d716,728 (Albany S. Ct. 2002);
- (2) all "single-purpose" appropriation bills that the Legislature passed for each of the three prior fiscal years, to wit, fiscal years 2000-2001; 1999-2000; 1998-1999, and transmitted to the Governor- and records of the Governor's actions thereon:
- (3) all "single-purpose" appropriation bills that the Legislature passed for each of the four subsequent fiscal years, to wit, fiscal years 2002-2003; 2003-2004; 2004-2005; 2005-2006, and transmitted to the Governor and records of the Governor's actions thereon;
- (4) all "single-purpose" appropriation bills that the Legislature passed for the current fiscal year and each of the previous three, to wit, fiscal years: 2017-2018; 2016-2017; 2015-2016; 2014-2015, and transmitted to the Governor and records of the Governor's actions thereon.

The New York State Executive Chamber has conducted a diligent search but does not possess records responsive to your request.
