Please be advised that some of the records that respond to your request are exempt from disclosure and have been withheld pursuant to:

- Public Officers Law § 87(2)(a), which provides that records that are exempt from disclosure by state or federal statute are exempt from disclosure under FOIL. The records constitute confidential communication[s] made between attorney and client, which is exempt from disclosure under Civil Practice Law and Rules § 4503(a). See *Morgan v. New York State Department of Environmental Conservation*, 9 A.D.3d 586, 587 (3rd Dept. 2004);
- Public Officers Law § 87(2)(a), which provides that records that are exempt from disclosure by state or federal statute are exempt from disclosure under FOIL. The records constitute attorney work product, which is exempt from disclosure under Civil Practice Law and Rules § 3101(c); and
- Public Officers Law § 87(2)(g), because the records are inter-agency or intra-agency materials.

You have a right to appeal the foregoing decision. If you elect to do so, you must appeal in writing, within 30 days, to Kathryn Sheingold, Records Appeals Officer.
