Dear Elena Sassower:

This letter responds to your correspondence dated September 3, 2019, which pursuant to FOIL, requested:

the following pertaining to the Public Campaign Financing and Election Commission, established by Part XXX of Revenue Budget Bill #S.1509-C1A.2009-C:

- (1) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission established a website and what that website is:
- (2) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission announced its contact information, to with a phone number, e-mail address, and mailing address and what they are;
- (3) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission established a physical office address and where it is;
- (4) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission secured/hired staff- and how many and whether they are employed full-time in the operations of the Commission;
- (5) records reflecting when, if as yet, the Commission secured a budget to pay staff and expenses and what that budget is;
- (6) records reflecting when and in what fashion the Commission announced its first meeting and to whom the announcement was disseminated;
- (7) the video of the Commission's first public meeting, on August 21,2Al9 and any transcription thereof;

- (8) minutes/transcriptions of any prior and subsequent Commission meetings, including meetings held in executive session;
- (9) records reflecting when and in what fashion the Commission announced the dates and locations of its public hearings;
- (10) records reflecting when, if at all, the Commission announced registration procedures for testifying at its public hearings and what they are.

The New York State Executive Chamber does not maintain or possess records of the Public Campaign Financing and Election Commission ("Commission"). Pursuant to Public Officers Law § 89(4)(a), you have thirty (30) days to take a written appeal of this determination. You may appeal by writing: FOIL Appeals Officer, Executive Chamber, State Capitol, Albany, New York, 12224.
