Dear Mr. Boyle:

In response to your fax, we did not believe that the information requested in our today's letter would require more than a few minutes' time--given that the AP story is readily available to you by computer--if not directly from Ms. Mills.

Our inquiry does not require your personal attention--and certainly we did not intend any imposition upon you.

We do believe that, as Chief of Staff, you are in a position to see to it that our inquiry is answered--whether by Ms. Mills who wrote the story or by a subordinate on the AP staff.

Considering that our citizens' group--working completely pro bono--invested more than six months time and thousands of dollars on materials which Ms. Mills reviewed in writing her story, we do not at all consider our request unreasonable.

Please give favorable consideration to our request since we have been waiting for more than a month.
