Thank you for your prompt, albeit unceremonious, response to my e-mail.
Is this also your response to my August 16th memo to you?

And what about your "promise" to me on that date -- memorialized by your inscription to me in your paperback -- to "examine the evidence" rebutting your view that The Times is a "gold standard" of objective, high-quality journalism and that its first editor, Daniel Okrent, had done a "great" job. What are the results of your examination of the documentary evidence enclosed by my August 16th memo -- and of CJA's mountain of correspondence and complaints with The Times, posted on the "Press Suppression-New York Times" page of CJA's website, www.judgewatch.org?

Finally, my August 16th memo requested (at p. 8) "your recommendations as to who among your colleagues has the journalistic integrity to expose The Times' knowing and deliberate betrayal of the public trust, as documented by our long-history of correspondence and complaints to its highest echelons..." Do you have no such recommendations to offer?

I await your clarification. Meantime, I will forward this exchange to Jayson, to whom my e-mail was also addressed and who you have apparently failed to cc.
