RE: Henry Hyde and the House Judiciary Committee's *Other Impeachment Duties*  
*Impeachment Complaint against U.S. Supreme Court Justices*

Dear Knut:

As discussed, enclosed is a copy of CJA's impeachment complaint against the Justices of the United States Supreme Court, dated November 6th, together with the certified receipts reflecting mailing to both the Republican Majority and Democratic Minority of the House Judiciary Committee. Also enclosed is our coverletter to the U.S. Supreme Court, also with the certified mailing receipt.

Four grounds for the Justices' impeachment are delineated at page 2, with a fifth ground set forth as to Chief Justice Rehnquist in his capacity as head of the Judicial Conference of the United States.

As noted on page 3, quoting from the *Sassower v. Mangano* rehearing petition:

"Once Congress has concluded its impeachment deliberations as to the President, it will have the benefit of its newly-acquired expertise to turn its attention to the indisputably impeachable conduct of the federal judiciary." (at p. 10)

Today's historic House Judiciary Committee hearing can be expected to further the growing sensitivity of Congress, the press, and the American People to the definition of impeachable offenses -- and the legitimacy of this impeachment complaint against the Justices, and of CJA's prior two impeachment complaints against the lower federal judiciary.
