MESSAGE:

We are a grass-roots citizens group concerned with the politicization of the judiciary. This politicization is exemplified by, inter alia, the record of the New York State Board of Elections which demonstrates over and again its indifference to the express provisions of the Election Law designed to prevent corrupt practices by politicians.

The State Board of Elections has TODAY accepted the Election Law violations on the face of the certificates of nominations of the Democratic, Republican, and Conservative Parties, as well as the admission by Judge Silverman, reported in the Gannett news story of September 29, 1991, that the quid pro quo for his declination of nomination was the promise of next year's nomination.
