My supervisors have asked me to respond on their behalf to your facsimile letters of November 21, 2002 and November 22, 2002, and inform you that our office does not intend to withdraw either my November 8, 2002 Affirmation in opposition to your October 15, 2002 motion for reargument, or the Commission's November 8, 2002 Memorandum of Law in opposition to your October 24, 2002 motion for leave to appeal.
