Thank you for your August 6, 1999 letter regarding the above-entitled action. In your letter, you have asked this office to consider your July 28, 1999 affidavit and memorandum of law as an ethics complaint against the Attorney General, Richard Rifkin, and the "staff and supervisory personnel" involved in this litigation.

As you know, the allegations set forth in the materials that you provided are now the subject of a pending motion in State Supreme Court. In addition, it appears that you have submitted related allegations to the State Ethics Commission. Finally, you have expressly requested that your allegations be considered an ethics complaint against the Attorney General, who is the head of this agency. In view of these considerations, we have determined that it would not be advisable for this office to undertake a separate internal review of your allegations.
