

Dear Mr. Wheeler:

It was a pleasure talking with you Friday morning September 24th about the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act Study Committee. I am enclosing a copy of a document I sent to Congressman James Sensenbrenner and Senator Jeff Sessions. The document chronicles the handling of a judicial misconduct complaint I filed against Judge Frank M. Hull at the 11th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals, a letter from my Congressman to another Congressman regarding my concerns and several pertinent articles. I hope this document can provide an example of why many citizens have lost respect for the Federal Judiciary, why self policing is not working and why change must be made in the method of reviewing judicial misconduct.

In our conversation I believe you mentioned some 600-misconduct complaints that meet certain criteria would be reviewed and commented on next fall. I would be interested in knowing if my complaint met the criteria and if the 11th Circuit provided my complaint for review. Should additional documents such as District Court, Court of Appeals and Supreme Court filings be needed in review of judicial misconduct in my case I would welcome the opportunity to share them.
