REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE,  
DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT AGAINST ALLAN FRIEDBERG ESQ.

Dear Mr. Friedberg,

Thank you for your response to my fax of December 18, 2008.

You write: **“We are unable to comply with your request for copies of the October 20<sup>th</sup> and November 10, 2008 letter [to Myron Beldock re: Jeffrey Greenberg].”**

When you say “we are unable to comply” do you mean you are “unable to comply” due to any specific rule or regulation that prohibits compliance or do you mean that you are simply unwilling to comply for reasons of your own?

If you are merely “unwilling”, but state that you are “unable”, that would constitute a violation of :

DR 7-102. Representing a Client Within the Bounds of the Law

- (a) In the representation of a client, a lawyer shall not: **(5) knowingly make a false statement of law or fact.**

**Please answer the above question immediately. If you cannot explain why your statement is true by January 1, 2008, please consider this letter a formal disciplinary complaint against you, for violation of DR 7-102 (a) (5).**
