Appellant, pro se, moves for leave to proceed in forma pauperis (“IFP”) in her consolidated appeals taken from summary judgment granted to the Appellees and the imposition of a filing injunction. Appellant also moves for reconsideration of this Court’s August 12, 2026 order, which denied her motion to hold these appeals in abeyance, and for leave to file limited supplemental exhibits to support her reconsideration motion. Upon due consideration, it is hereby ORDERED that the IFP motions are DENIED and the appeals are DISMISSED because they “lack[] an arguable basis either in law or in fact.” *Neitzke v. Williams*, 490 U.S. 319, 325 (1989); *see* 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e). It is further ORDERED that the remaining motions are DENIED as moot.
