RE: Media-unreported stories about the House Judiciary Committee's handling of HUNDREDS of impeachment complaints against federal judges -- and CJA's November 6, 1998 impeachment complaint against Chief Justice Rehnquist

Dear Ms. Bates:

As discussed, I believe the black community has a particular interest in ensuring the efficacy of mechanisms to discipline and remove biased and dishonest federal judges. This, in addition to its general support for the continued presidency of Mr. Clinton.

Jet may, therefor, be particularly receptive to the stories presented by the Center for Judicial Accountability's enclosed two press releases -- stories about the *official* misconduct of the House Judiciary Committee and Chief Justice Rehnquist in corrupting those mechanisms, with the potential to blow apart the Senate impeachment trial.

Should there be any doubt as to the explosive significance of these stories, we would be pleased to transmit the substantiating documentation: our FIVE-YEAR correspondence with the House Judiciary Committee concerning its handling of citizen-filed impeachment complaints against federal judges and November 6, 1998 impeachment complaint against the Chief Justice.
