## TO: Office of the NY State Comptroller - Division of Investigations AND Inspector General

This follows my phone conversation a short time ago with Melissa Walker, Administrator for Investigative Operations, who, picked up the phone upon my calling your hotline #1-888-672-4555 "To report fraud outside of OSC". The basis of the complaint is, for starters, two larcenous appropriations in the FY2025-25 state budget:

- (1) \$34.6M or so for judicial pay raises, embedded in Legislative/Judiciary Budget Bill #S.3001/A.3001, arising from the statutorily-violative, fraudulent, and unconstitutional December 4, 2023 Report of the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation; and
- (2) unknown sums for pay raises for Executive Law §169 state officers, embedded in State Operations Budget Bill #S.3000/A.3000, arising from the statutorily-violative, fraudulent, and unconstitutional November 14, 2024 Report also of the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation.

These two larcenies are highlighted by my two-page February 4, 2025 written testimony to the Legislature for its budget hearing on "local government officials/general government", which attached, in substantiation, CJA's February 3, 2025 Opposition Report to the Commission's November 14, 2024 Report.

Comptroller DiNapoli is likely already familiar with the February 3, 2025 Opposition Report, as I already sent it to him, twice, *via* his Counsel for State Audit & Litigation Michael Kogut, by the below February 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> e-mails. It is above-attached.

As I stated last year by my <u>January 30, 2024 e-mail to you</u>, a copy of which Ms. Walker accessed while we spoke and which, on January 30, 2024, I had sent shortly after a hotline conversation with Investigator Patrick Lanza, who Ms. Walker stated still works in your office:

"please deem this as a formal complaint for investigation – including as to corruption and conflict-of-interest <u>inside the OSC</u> with respect to this issue – a matter over which the OSC Inspector General has jurisdiction."
