Dear Professor –

There is nothing partisan about what I have presented – which is about public corruption by two incumbent officers in Onondaga County, who happen to be Republican – but which not only brings them down, in scandal, but a who's who of incumbents of both major political parties – starting with those at the very top of our three government branches: a Democratic governor, attorney general, and comptroller, the Democratic leaders of the Senate and Assembly, and the Democratic chief judge. No political candidates originated this story – and the two DA Candidates I have contacted, (Republican) Lavine and (Democrat) Keller, are not commenting on what I have furnished them, for their own political, self-serving reasons, demonstrative of their unfitness for the DA office they seek, resting, as it does on evaluating EVIDENCE and bringing prosecutions based thereon.

The citizen-taxpayer action is about collusion between the government branches and the political parties – covered up by the press, which has suppressed, entirely, what has been going on, laid out, with open-and-shut EVIDENCE, in the ten causes of action in the lawsuit – and by its record.

There must be academic scholarship of what has been going on – as documented by EVIDENCE. That is the role of universities and academic institutes. And there must be press investigation and report. Yet, for years – and now – the press suppresses ALL report of what has been and is going on – rigging elections, in the process. This I have documented, by EVIDENCE, as well.

Syracuse University has the Maxwell School, has a law school, has a journalism school. Please make the appropriate referrals for scholarship and investigative reporting – and recognize that your own Campbell conversations, as valuable as they are, give public officers a relatively free forum to spin and mislead the public. This includes Antonacci and Fitzpatrick, in your recent conversations with them. Meantime, I will forward you what I e-mailed to WRVO's Jason Smith a short time ago, before seeing your below e-mail.
