The corruption of New York's First Dept. Disciplinary Committee – and of New York's attorney disciplinary system and Commission on Judicial Conduct – were the subject of hearings, in 2009, by New York's then Senate Judiciary Committee Chair, John Sampson – which were aborted, *without* investigation, *without* findings, and *without* any committee report.
