Dear Women's Forum Member,

As you may know, I have been a member of the Women's Forum virtually since its inception. When I joined, back in the seventies, I was a lawyer for twenty years, well-known for my work at the forefront of the feminist movement, resulting in many important changes.

For those unfamiliar with my background in the fight for equal rights, I enclose a copy of my credentials as they appeared in Martindale-Hubbell's Law Directory five years ago. Since that time, I have been fighting a most unexpected personal and professional battle--which you may have read about in an advertisement appearing on the Op-Ed page of the October 26th New York Times. For those who missed it, I enclose a copy.

Although I have received an overwhelming response from people around the country, expressing their concern and support, I have heard nothing from any Women's Forum members. I find this most disturbing since what the ad describes is not only the vicious retaliation to which I have been subjected for my judicial whistle-blowing, but also the corruption of our justice system and basic constitutional rights.

The Women's Forum was intended to create a network of powerful women who could provide support to one another and thereby advance important societal goals. By writing directly to members of the Women's Forum, I hope to elicit that much-needed support in what is a herculean effort to make fundamental and vitally necessary change in our third branch of government.

I am now building a national organization for that purpose, the Center for Judicial Accountability. I invite you to be part of it and to "spread the word" in your spheres of influence. For that purpose, I am, additionally, enclosing information about the Center, which we have been sending to people who have responded to our ad. Please feel free to duplicate it and pass it on.

Those of you in the media have an especially important role to play since there has been virtually no media coverage of what has been done to me or how the public trust has been betrayed by politically-motivated courts.

I look forward to speaking with you personally or by phone.
