Title of Bill:

An act to amend the New York City Civil Court Act, in relation to candidates for the position of housing judge.

Purpose:

To give greater access to the public of lists of possible housing judges in the State of New York.

Summary of Specific Provisions:

The list of persons who have been approved by such advisory council, whether or not appointed to such judicial position shall be deemed public information and be published in the city record immediately after such list is submitted to the administrative judge.

Effects of Present Law which This Bill Would Alter:

It would allow greater access to lists of housing judge candidates to the general public.

Justification:

This measure will allow the public at large, and interested parties, to be aware of possible candidates for housing judge positions and voice support or concern regarding possible candidates.

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision (f) of section 110 of the New York city civil
2 court act, as amended by chapter 518 of the laws of 1994, is amended to
3 read as follows:
4 (f) The housing judges shall be appointed by the administrative judge
5 from a list of persons selected annually as qualified by training,
6 interest, experience, judicial temperament and knowledge of federal,
7 state and local housing laws and programs by the advisory council for
8 the housing part. The list of persons who have been approved by such
9 advisory council, whether or not appointed to such judicial position,
10 shall be deemed public information and be published in the city record
11 immediately after such list is submitted to the administrative judge.
