The petition for a writ of certiorari in the "disruption of Congress" case -- that Tom reported on in April and July 2004 and which *Legal Times* featured in its 2004 year-end issue -- is posted on the Center for Judicial Accountability's website, [www.judgwatch.org](http://www.judgwatch.org), accessible via the top panel "Latest News", as well as via the sidebar panel "'Disruption of Congress' - The Appeals".
