Thanks for your e-mail. January is PERFECT for the National Lawyers Guild amicus curiae brief on my second and third appellate issues: the venue provision of the "disruption of Congress" statute and the constitutionality of the statute, as written and as applied.

The status of the appeal is as follows. I was compelled to file my 50-page "conforming brief on the merits" on November 7th. The second and third issues are UNCHANGED from my original June 28th appellant's brief. They remain 1-1/4 and 10 pages, respectively.

The U.S. Attorney has applied for an extension of time for filing its brief until January 27th -- which leaves ample time for you to file the Guild's amicus brief in early-mid January.

The pertinent documents are posted on CJA's website: www.judgewatch.org. [see sidebar panel "disruption of Congress"]. This includes Professor Horwitz' amicus curiae brief on the fourth appellate issue relating to probation terms and the sixth-month jail sentence.
