Subject: The Scandal that Ends William Thompson's Mayoral Run -- & Opens the Race to Good-Government Champions (Like Adolfo Carrion?)

Dear Mr. Keisman,

Following our brief conversation, here's the direct link to the webpage of our website, posting our People's lawsuit against the state based on William Thompson's fraud and criminal conduct as chairman of the Special Commission on Judicial Compensation: <http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/judicial-compensation/cja-v-governor.htm> . As discussed, Mr. Thompson's misconduct has cost NYS taxpayers approximately \$40 million to date, will be, by the end of this fiscal year, approximately \$70 million, will reach more than \$100 million by the end of next fiscal year, and will thereafter cost NYS taxpayers approximately \$50 million each year, in perpetuity

The March 30, 2012 verified complaint is the best summary of the background and immediate aftermath of what Mr. Thompson did. The allegations pertaining to his June 10, 2011 appointment by Governor Cuomo as chairman of the Commission on Judicial Compensation and his brazen disregard of conflict of interest rules and subsequent fraud and corruption in that capacity, covered up and endorsed by the Governor and New York's highest constitutional officers – all named defendants in the suit -- begin at para. 77 and, from there, summarize the particulars of what is presented, with full documentary substantiation, by our October 27, 2011 Opposition Report to the Commission on Judicial Compensation's August 29, 2011 Final Report. We have furnished the March 30, 2012 verified complaint and its incorporated exhibits – most importantly our October 27, 2011 Opposition Report -- to US Attorneys Bharara (SDNY); Lynch (EDNY); and Hartunian (NDNY) for investigation, prosecution, & intervention. If you view my testimony & exchange with Chairman Thompson on the issue of his disqualification – you will have the best explanation as to why the Commission took down the video from its website since shortly before its August 29, 2011 Final Report.

I look forward to discussing with you the most opportune time and way to release this story to the media so that it can be of greatest help to Mr. Carrion in his mayoral run...
