Where is Mr. Slattery's reporting on Assemblyman Lentol's record, in office, such as I discussed with you two weeks ago – and furnished you by the below.

To assist you in helping Mr. Slattery and other journalists investigate and report on Assemblyman Lentol's record, in office – beginning with the pay raises and the budget – attached is the corruption/grand jury complaint I filed against him with Brooklyn District Attorney Gonzalez on June 9th. The EVIDENCE to which it refers is all accessible from CJA's webpage for the complaint, here: <http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/searching-nys/2020-legislative/grand-juries.htm> – and establishes that Assemblyman Lentol cannot be re-elected, because he must be indicted – and that he will be convicted.

Shouldn't Candidate Gallagher be calling for Assemblyman Lentol's **immediate** response to that EVIDENCE, which he has long had – and calling for an expedited time-table from the Brooklyn D.A. for his preliminary investigation/grand jury inquiry?
