Subject: **Libertarian Party Candidate Schmidt can easily WIN vs NYS Comptroller DiNapoli -- all it requires is using the bully pulpit of his candidacy to "whistle-blow". Likewise, Candidate Hayes can easily WIN vs NYS AG James**

Following up our brief phone conversation a few hours ago, below is the e-mail I sent yesterday to the Libertarian Party's NYS Comptroller Candidate William Schmidt, who I see is a plaintiff in your [federal lawsuit](#) in which you have won a preliminary injunction. As I mentioned, in 2020, I tried, without success, to assist the Libertarian Party in challenging the increased voter and petitioning thresholds that were unconstitutionally inserted in the FY2020-21 state budget. As Mr. Schmidt does not appear to have a website for his candidacy – and I am unable to find a phone number for him – I would appreciate if you would furnish me with his phone number, so that I may speak with him directly about my below e-mail. I have meantime found a Libertarian Party e-mail address for him on the Libertarian Party's webpage for "[Leadership](#)" – and am sending this e-mail to him now via that address – adding, for his review, my here [linked](#) self-explanatory e-mail to Comptroller DiNapoli of today's date.

As the Libertarian Party is also running a candidate for NYS Attorney General – Sean Hayes – and the corruption issues that bring down Comptroller DiNapoli also bring down Attorney General James, I am cc'ing Mr. Hayes, who has a [website, with an e-mail address for his candidacy](#), with a request that he call me – additionally cc'ing NYS Libertarian Party Chair Cody Anderson and Vice Chairs Tony D'Orazio and Duane Whitmer, also inviting them to call.

Neither Comptroller DiNapoli nor Attorney General James can be re-elected, because they must be indicted for their corruption – and will be convicted – based on open-and-shut, *prima facie* EVIDENCE – and the Libertarian Party should organize a press conference for its candidates and lawyers to demand that NYS' criminal and ethics authorities that have been "sitting on" the fully-documented complaints get moving on investigation and prosecution.

TO: Libertarian Party Candidate William Schmidt

Thank you for your patriotism and running against Comptroller Tom DiNapoli.

I am director and co-founder of the non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA) – based in White Plains.

You can win, easily & without \$, against Comptroller DiNapoli. It requires nothing more than using the bully pulpit of your candidacy to "whistle-blow" about his corruption, in office -- the subject of fully-documented criminal and ethics complaints vs him and his fellow corrupt public officers, involving pay raises and the state budget. Among these: (1) [my June 4, 2020 grand jury/public corruption complaint to the Albany County D.A.](#) (EVIDENTIARY webpage, [here](#)); (2) [my October 16, 2020 complaint to the FBI](#); (3) my complaints, based thereon, to New York's four U.S. Attorneys, [former](#) & [current](#), spanning from November 3, 2020 to December 23, 2021; and (4) [my March 5, 2021 complaint to JCOPE](#). All involve the three lawsuits I brought against the state, suing DiNapoli as a defendant – the first challenging pay raises, and the second two, citizen-taxpayer actions, additionally challenging the state budget. My testimony before Comptroller DiNapoli about these three lawsuits at the November 30, 2018 hearing of the Committee on Legislative and Executive Compensation, of which he was a member with former state Comptroller McCall, former NYC Comptroller Thompson, and the then NYC Comptroller Stringer, is posted, with the EVIDENCE I handed-up, [here](#). There is also a fourth lawsuit, also suing DiNapoli – a combined Article 78 proceeding/declaratory judgment action/citizen-taxpayer action – commenced last month, also challenging the constitutionality and lawfulness of the state budget and the pay raises. As will swiftly be obvious to you, Comptroller DiNapoli cannot be re-elected, because he must be indicted – and will be convicted, as likewise the many other public officers who have colluded with him and who are running in this year's races – Governor Hochul, Attorney General James, and New York's state legislators, among them.

Please call me so that I can help you evaluate this, answer your questions, and develop successful strategies.
