Subject: **True reforms, upon which public faith in NY government rests, requires outing & ousting Holyman because he has corrupted his office, for years.**

I am director & co-founder of the non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA), based in White Plains, New York.

Thank you for challenging Senator Hoylman in the upcoming Democratic Party primary. You can win, easily, and without money. All it takes is “whistle-blowing” about Hoylman’s corruption, in office – which I have documented for years, beginning in 2013-2016, when he was ranking member of the Senate Committee on Investigations and Government Operations and a member of the Senate Judiciary Committee, in 2017-2018, when he was ranking member of BOTH those committees, and since 2019 as chair of the Senate Judiciary Committee.

I have filed a succession of ethics and criminal complaints against him and his fellow corrupters of this state’s governance – with JCOPE, with the Albany District Attorney, with the Manhattan District Attorney, with the FBI, and U.S. Attorneys – which they are “sitting on”. This, in addition to major lawsuits, “thrown” by fraudulent judicial decisions.

I am available to assist you, to the max – in exposing Hoylman’s record as senator, occupying key leadership positions, for which he must not only be repudiated by the voters, but indicted by criminal authorities. Indeed, the EVIDENCE against him is open-and-shut, *prima facie* -- & he will be convicted. This includes for the so-called “ethics commission reform act of 2022” that replaced JCOPE with the Commission on Ethics and Lobbying in Government, about which you write, with Sal Albanese, in “[Long Overdue Reforms and the Road to Instilling Public Faith in New York Government](#)” published in today’s [Gotham Gazette](#). On that subject – and because both you and Mr. Albanese are lawyers -- here’s the [NYSCEF link to CJA’s lawsuit](#), suing Hoylman and his fellow legislators, among others, for their fraud and flagrant constitutional and statutory violations pertaining thereto.
