Dear Mr. Dietl,

I am co-founder and director of the non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA).

This follows our brief phone conversation together, a short time ago, and before that, my conversations with Emily and then Jasmine – occasioned by my reading the Daily News' August 7th article "[Bo Dietl forms PAC to fight Mamdani, with help from Rudy Giuliani](#)" by Josephine Stratman & Chris Sommerfeldt.

I can help you LEAD the many PACs in taking down Mamdani, EASILY and WITHOUT MONEY. All it requires is whistle-blowing about **Mamdani's corruption, in office, as a NYS assemblyman** – the EVIDENCE of which the press has had, but not reported – both before the June 24th primary and since. The proof is posted on CJA's website, www.judgewatch.org, accessible from the prominent center link "**ELECTIONS 2025 -- INFORMING THE VOTERS -- ALERT: Corrupt candidates & incumbents are on the ballot.**"

An easy starting point is my July 24th e-mail to the Daily News – including to Stratman and Sommerfeldt – entitled "NYC ELECTIONS: Will you be reporting on Mamdani's corruption as a NYS assemblyman, starting with his pocketing of fraudulent pay raises for himself -- &, likewise, the corruption of NYS Senator Hoylman-Sigal, & other Democratic primary winners?", to which there was NO response. It is below.

ALL the open-and-shut, *prima facie* EVIDENCE, for which **Mamdani must be indicted and will be convicted** is accessible from the July 24th e-mail, including my above-attached March 14th e-mail to Mamdani. Mr. Giuliani, as a former U.S. Attorney, can confirm the dispositive nature of that EVIDENCE – and that it is also dispositive that Letitia James and Alvin Bragg must also be indicted, among a "who's who" of others, long protected by NY's "fake news", election-rigging press. Please forward to him.

I look forward to discussing this further with you and Mr. Giuliani.

Will you be reporting on Mamdani's corruption as a NYS assemblyman – starting with his pocketing of pay raises for himself that he knew to be fraudulent? The EVIDENCE is furnished by my [March 14th e-mail to Mamdani](#) entitled “ELECTIONS ARE A TIME OF ACCOUNTABILITY”, which opened as follows.

“Elections are a time of accountability. Based on your on-the-job performance as a state assemblyman, why do you believe yourself fit to be mayor of New York City – or for any office of public trust?”.

Mamdani did not respond – and I sent him the March 14th e-mail a second time, with a supplement, by a [March 17th email](#), and then a third time, when I cc'd him on my [March 18th e-mail](#) to the roster of reporters of the Legislative Correspondents Association, and then a fourth time, when I cc'd him on my [March 20th e-mail](#) to you, The New York Times, New York Post, New York Law Journal, Wall Street Journal, and Associated Press.

Will you be getting Mamdani's response to my March 14th “ELECTIONS ARE A TIME OF ACCOUNTABILITY” e-mail? Isn't it obvious that it – and his votes, seven weeks later, approving the FY2025-26 state budget

bills – establish that he cannot be elected NYC mayor because he must be indicted for larceny and corruption – and that he will be convicted? Why don't you confirm that fact with [former Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of New York Jim Walden](#), running for mayor as an Independent candidate, with an [anti-corruption policy platform featured on his campaign website](#). By the way, are you aware that [Mamdani's campaign website contains no anti-corruption platform](#)?

Also, will you be reporting on the corruption of other NYC Democratic primary winners, such as NYS Senator Brad Hoylman-Sigal, running for Manhattan borough president. The EVIDENCE of his corruption is furnished by my [March 16th e-mail](#) to him, likewise entitled "ELECTIONS ARE A TIME OF ACCOUNTABILITY..." – part of my March 20th e-mail to you to which both Mamdani and Hoylman-Sigal were cc'd.

Finally, if it is not your intention to report on the open-and-shut, *prima facie* EVIDENCE of the corruption of Mamdani, Hoylman-Sigal, and other NYC Democratic primary winners that you enabled – incumbents NYC Public Advocate Jumanne Williams, Manhattan D.A. Alvin Bragg, and Brooklyn D.A. Eric Gonzalez topping the list – please forward this e-mail to [Daily News](#) legal counsel and ownership, consistent with what my [April 18th e-mail](#) to you requested in furnishing you with my March 20th e-mail a second time.

Please advise, promptly – as TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE, obviously. I am available to answer questions and will meanwhile phone in "**News Tips to City Desk: 212-210-NEWS**".
