LIPSON, DAVID

David Lipson, of New Rochelle, NY, 80, on January 24, 2000 at the Bronx VA Medical Center.

Beloved brother of Doris L. Sassower of White Plains, NY; Joel Lipson of Monsey, NY; and Judith Noebels of Geneva, Switzerland. David was the son of Rose Weitz, founder and first President of Williamsburg Jewish Center, and Abraham Lipson, who immigrated as children from Grodek, Austria in the early 1900's. A First Lieutenant in World War II, David enlisted in the United States Air Corps at 19, serving more than four years. He returned from the Philippines to complete his BA in mathematics at Brooklyn College, scoring in the 99th percentile nationwide. Scholar and teacher, he then earned a Masters at NYU, where he also pursued a Ph.D.

Adored uncle of Elena, Carey, Beth, Maury, Ira, Laurie, Jeffrey, and Jill.

Funeral services with Military Honor Guard were held on January 27. Shiva at 283 Soundview Avenue, White Plains, callers from 2-5 pm. In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations to the Jewish National Fund to plant trees in Israel in David's memory.
