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INVESTIGATE THE CORRUPT ACTIVITIES AND IMPEACH
CHIEF JUDGE WILFRED FEINBERG, CIRCUIT JUDGE IRVING R. KAUFMAN,
CIRCUIT JUDGE THOMAS J. MESKILL, and DISTRICT JUDGE EUGENE H.
NICKERSON.

1a. District Judge James H. Peck, based on a non-summary contempt power he believed he had, incarcerated Luke E. Lawless, Esq., for 1 day and disbarred him from the federal courts for 18 months, without benefit of trial. Short fused reactions, are attributes of all living species, including the human. Although almost always inexcusable, they do occur, even in the best.

b. Mr. Lawless will be "the last victim" of such judicial abuse of the contempt power said Congressman James Buchanan (Nye v. U.S., 313 U.S. 33, 46), thereafter the 15th President of the U.S., as he led the fight Judge Peck's impeachment, and the passage of the Act of March 2, 1831 (Ex parte Robinson, 19 Wall [86 U.S.] 505).

c. Since that time, every judge knows, that absent a plea of guilty, as a matter of ministerial compulsion, the accused must be given a trial before he can be convicted of non-summary criminal contempt. Congress made certain that federal judges do not have the jurisdictional power to do otherwise.

2a. Calmly and deliberately, in an attempt to advance a criminal adventure, District Court Eugene H. Nickerson convicted me and my client of non-summary criminal contempt, without a trial, and without even taking the testimony of my accuser, which conviction was affirmed by the Circuit Court, who stated that a hearing was not needed.

b. A hearing is needed to prove that my accuser simply does not even have a prima facie case for conviction; a hearing is needed, because the District Court and Circuit Court do not have jurisdiction without same; a hearing is needed to vindicate the rights of individuals in a civilized society.

b. Federal judicial tyrants, who knowingly transgress the limits of their jurisdictional power, to convict the innocent, without due process, in order to aid, abet, and facilitate the larceny of judicial trust assets, and other criminal conduct, simply have no place in an American judicial society.

c. Respect for judicial history mandates that they be impeached. The law's demand for equality, irresistibly compels that they be investigated, indicted, and given a legal trial -- a trial which they denied me.
