Enclosed find my letter of February 7, 1989 to Chairman Sol Wachtler of the Administrative Board of the Unified Court System, which contains the demand that the Chairman request and receive the resignation of Presiding Justice Francis T. Murphy.

I also enclose my letters of the same date to Presiding Justice Francis T. Murphy, containing my own demand for the Presiding Justice's resignation.

Requested of you personally is the request that you immediately initiate an investigation of the whereabouts of all my complaint letter to your agency over the past several years with respect to **Kreindler & Relkin, P.C.** and **Feltman, Karesh, Major & Farbman, Esqs.** --"the criminals with law degrees" and "the merchants of corruption.

Inquiry has revealed such complaint correspondence has been secreted and/or destroyed, including that which was sent by certified mail.

I consider the above, including the unethical and criminal conduct of the Kreindler and Feltman firms, to be matters of public interest, and have and will continue to make same the subject of media distribution.
