

criminal enterprise whose activities include the `diversion` of judicial trust assets to and/or on behalf of members of the judiciary, compelling her `disbarment`.

Since I anticipate that no one will show, or even claim, that *Aprilanne Agostino*, Esq. had `jurisdiction` to dispose of my disciplinary complaints, my complaint of May 29, 2012 should be considered as active & still pending appropriate & lawful disposition which, I request, the Grievance Committee confirm by return mail."

Count "B":

Although I never received the "*phantom*" request letter, nor any claim by anyone that *Aprilanne Agostino*, Esq. had `jurisdiction` to dispose of my disciplinary complaints, the "*fixed*" *Diana Maxfield Kears*e, Esq., as far as I am aware has refused to process my complaint of May 29, 2012.
