Your attention is drawn to the fact that an Assistant Attorney General was representing, at federal cost and expense, federal judges without a 28 U.S.C. §2679[d] scope certification for activities which included diverting monies payable "to the federal court" to the private pockets of their cronies, and other criminal racketeering activities.


You are reminded that 160 years ago, Congressman James Buchanan, Chairman of the Judiciary Committee, thereafter the 15th President of the United States, promised that Luke Lawless, Esq. was to be "the last victim" as Congress enacted the Act of March 2, 1831 (Nye v. U.S., 313 U.S. 33, 45-46 [1941]).

Notwithstanding such Congressional promise, I have been repeatedly incarcerated and fined without a trial, without an opportunity for a trial and without any live testimony in support of such non-summary criminal contempt convictions, at great cost and expense to the government.

I assure you, your committees, and Congress, as an American born citizen and battle-starred veteran of World War II, I have no intention of abandoning my oath-bound obligations to the U.S. Constitution, irrespective of the personal costs involved.

I look forward to testifying personally at the confirmation hearings of Acting Attorney General William P. Barr.
