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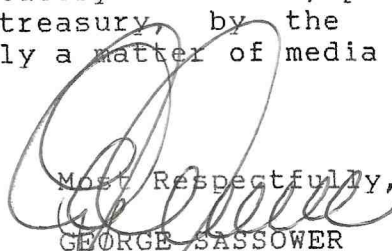

Dear Chairman Brooks,

I respectfully request that demand be made upon Attorney General William P. Barr to explain his refusal to act upon my 28 U.S.C. §591 (Independent Counsel) complaints made eight months ago, although the statute mandates his action within a 15 day period.

My enclosed disciplinary complaint to the Supreme Court of the United States, clearly reveals his misconduct, as well as the misconduct of the Solicitor General, in defending federal judges and officials, at federal cost and expense, without a 28 U.S.C. §2679[d] "scope" certificate and who, inter alia, are diverting monies payable "to the federal court" to the pockets of their cronies.

Defiance of statutory mandates, particularly at the expense of the federal treasury, by the highest law enforcement officials, is clearly a matter of media interest and public concern.
