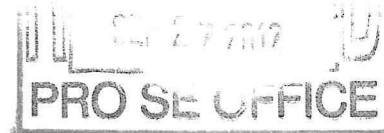

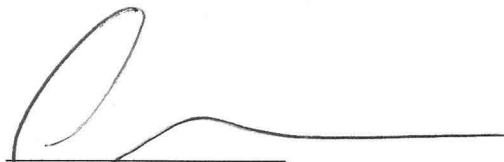

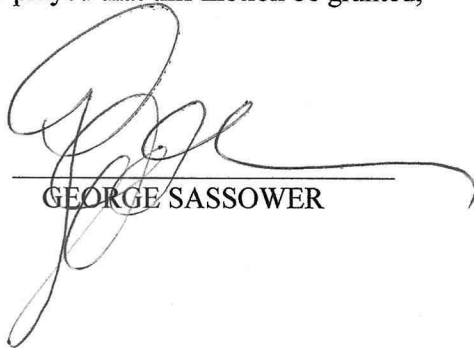
Thus there was nothing left to satisfy was motivated by “*bribe*” payments to judges.
