Honorable Sir:

1a. I respectfully request that Your Honor expedite Orders based on my motions returnable May 28, 1987 and June 1, 1987.

b. The Motion returnable May 28, 1987 was submitted without opposition, and the same, without opposition, seems to be the scenario for the June 1, 1987 motion.

c. Such Orders would probably make it unnecessary to serve and file my other approximately ten (10) other motions for summary judgment, which are presently in preparation.

2a. Based upon such Orders, I intend to return to the state forum and set aside such sham Order of Disbarment.

b. I know of no judge, federal or state, who would be willing to testify that the trial-less convictions for non-summary criminal contempt were lawful (cf. Sassower v. Sheriff (651 F. Supp. 128 [SDNY, per Edelstein, J.])), or that due process was afforded to any of the other charges.

3a. June 4, 1987, commences the eighth (8th) year since PUCCINI CLOTHES, LTD., was involuntarily dissolved. There is still no accounting, nor can any be truthfully filed without exposing the criminal activity involved therein.

b. The Disbarment Order has not redefined my object and purpose, but simply compelled me to focus my attention to the media and other non-judicial or traditional forums for relief.
