To proceed with your appeal, you must act on one of the following requirements:

- (a) Submit the appeal filing fee through the Pro Se Office. The fee is \$105.00 payable to the "Clerk of Court, USDC, SDNY" by certified check, money order or cash. No personal checks are accepted.

OR

- (b) Submit a motion directly to the Court of Appeals requesting that fees be waived.

Note that your notice of appeal will now be docketed "fees due" in this court, forwarded to the Orders and Appeals clerk and then transmitted to the Court of Appeals. The Court of Appeals will also notify you by mail on how to proceed when fees are due.
