Plaintiff, as and for his complaint, respectfully
sets forth and alleges:

1. Plaintiff brings this action directly under the
Constitution ((Article 1 §10[1], Amendments V, XIV), and laws of
the United States, with jurisdiction in the U.S. District Court
existing by virtue of 28 U.S.C. §1331 and 28 U.S.C. §1343.

2. Plaintiff, a private person, is a born American
citizen, and except for military service, has continually resided
in the United States and is entitled to all rights, privileges
and immunities due citizens under the Constitution and laws of
the United States.

3. Plaintiff's assets, all contractually based, and
coming within the protective umbrella of Article 1 §10[1] and
Amendment V of the United States Constitution, include the
following:

a. A wholly unsatisfied judgment against defendant,
PUCCINI CLOTHES, LTD. ["Puccini"] in the sum of \$27,912.42, with
interest from April 29, 1982.

b. A filed claim against Puccini for the sum of \$3,000,000.

c. An attorney's lien on the 25% stock interest of HYMAN RAFFE ["Raffe"] in Puccini.

d. An attorney's lien on a judgment in favor of Raffe against Puccini in the approximate sum of more than \$700,000, inclusive of interest.

e. An attorney's lien on a claim in favor of Raffe against Puccini in the approximate sum of more than \$50,000, inclusive of interest.

f. A legal and/or equitable lien on the stock interests in Puccini by defendants, EUGENE DANN ["Dann"] and ROBERT SORRENTINO ["Sorrentino"], by reason of (1) the aforementioned judgment of \$27,912.42, which includes Dann and Sorrentino, as judgment debtors, and (2) attorney's liens by virtue of various judgments and claims against them by Raffe.

4a. All of Puccini's assets were unlawfully conveyed, without any lawful consideration, to defendants LEE FELTMAN ["Feltman"], FELTMAN, KARESH, MAJOR & FARBMAN ["FKM&F"], KREINDLER & RELKIN, P.C ["K&R"], CITIBANK, N.A. ["Citibank"], and their co-conspirators, leaving nothing for the legitimate creditors, including plaintiff.

b. For consideration given and/or promised, the defendants, FRANCIS T. MURPHY ["Murphy"]; JAMES L. OAKES ["Oakes"] and CHARLES L. BRIEANT ["Brieant"] --- hereinafter "MOB" -- all of whom are sued herein in their personal, individual capacities, were enlisted to improperly employ their

influence with federal and state jurists in order to defeat, prejudice and impair plaintiff's constitutionally protected contractual rights, a course which MOB pursued with vengeance under "color of law".

5. In August of 1988, the Sheriff of the City of New York levied on the stock interest of Dann and Sorrentino in Puccini, but through the influence of the MOB entourage, the said Sheriff failed to execute on such levy.

6. By reason of the aforementioned, plaintiff demands a personal judgment against Murphy, Oakes, Brieant, Feltman, FKM&F, K&R, Citibank, Dann and Sorrentino in the sum of \$27,912.42 together with interest from April 29, 1982; the liquidation of plaintiff's other contractually based assets to sums certain, and judgment against all the defendants herein for such amount, except for Dann and Sorrentino; together with the costs and disbursements of this action.

The application is hereby granted. Let the applicant proceed without prepayment of cost or fees or the necessity of giving security therefor.

Affirmant, under penalty of perjury, makes this affirmation in support of the filing of the within complaint, in forma pauperis, and for a general bias recusal.

1a. The filing of this complaint, made as a matter of right, by virtue of Article III of the United States Constitution, providing for a federal judicial forum for "all" "cases or controversies" arising out of the Constitution or laws of the United States.

b. This action and/or the relief sought therein has never been litigated on its merits in any court of the United States, state or federal and therefore filed as a matter of right.

2a. Affirmant was not a party to the action in Raffe v. Doe (619 F. Supp. 891 [SDNY-1985]), nor were his interests, herein or otherwise, placed in issue in that action nor, by reason of such absence of status, was he permitted to appeal from said Order.

b. There were no trials, no hearings, no testimony,

no confrontation rights -- no nothing -- and disclosure and discovery stayed in Raffe v. Doe (supra).

c. Simply stated, the court-appointed receiver, acting under "color [pretense] of law" and his co-conspirators, with their cadre of corrupt jurists, state and federal, had their own private larcenous plans as to the disposition of the judicial trust assets of PUCCINI CLOTHES, LTD. ["Puccini"] -- "the judicial fortune cookie" -- and U.S. District Court Judge WILLIAM C. CONNER ["Conner"] accommodated himself to such desires.

d(1) The published Conner diatribe, was a concoction of contrived facts and assertions, and not the product of a scintilla of testimony.

(2) Affirmant, in his compelled poverty state, would no sooner negotiate with the "judicial thieves" than Churchill would negotiate with Hitler during the dark days of 1940.

e. In any event, injunctions terminate when the equities no longer exist for their continuation (Cable v. Alumina, 717 F. Supp. 1021, 1027 [SDNY-1988- per Conner, J.]).

3a. Judge Conner's services on behalf of his patrons did not cease with Raffe v. Doe (supra), but continued by, inter alia, "fixing memoranda" to jurists in this and other courts.

b. Thus, Chief U.S. Circuit Court Judge JAMES L. OAKES ["Oakes"] is intentionally sitting on a 28 U.S.C. §372[c] complaint against Judge Conner for eighteen months based upon the "Bill [Conner] to Terry [Haight]" "fixing memorandum" (CCA2d Docket No. 90-8561).

4. Since copies of this affirmation will be distributed elsewhere, it may serve a beneficial purpose to set forth some additional facts.

a(1) Also concocted, contrived and fabricated was the opinion in Sassower v. Sheriff (824 F.2d 184 [2d Cir.-1987]).

(2) When U.S. Magistrate Judge NINA GERSHON ["Gershon"] read in the Report of Referee DONALD DIAMOND ["Diamond"], the repeated statements that "a plea of not-guilty in a criminal proceeding is tantamount to a general denial in a civil action and raises no triable issue of fact" -- Her Honor's eyeballs figuratively bolted from their sockets (see Sassower v. Sheriff, 651 F. Supp. 128 [SDNY-1986]).

(3) Magistrate Gershon was unaware at the time, as was affirmant, that HYMAN RAFFE ["Raffe"] paid the judicial cronies -- "the criminals with law degrees" -- more than \$2,500,000 not to be incarcerated under a mirrored Referee Diamond Report, agreed to execute release in favor of, inter alia, the federal and state judiciary, and gave other unlawful consideration, including paying KREINDLER & RELKIN, P.C. ["K&R"] and its client, for their own private pockets, monies which were payable "to the federal court".

5a. Since under the sua sponte, without due process ukases of Chief U.S. District Court Judge CHARLES L. BRIEANT ["Brieant"], affirmant is not permitted to file papers, without permission, or even physically enter the Courthouse Building at 101 East Post Road, White Plains, New York, affirmant claims a

"general bias" state of affairs, and that the matter must be transferred to another circuit.

b. Additionally, because of the inclusion of some of the defendants herein, legally justified, all the judges in this circuit must recuse themselves, particularly since "fixing" is an acceptable currency in this circuit.

c(1) In 1977, after the issuance of one of the Judge Briant's ukases, affirmant stated that this Court is "Unfit for Human Litigation".

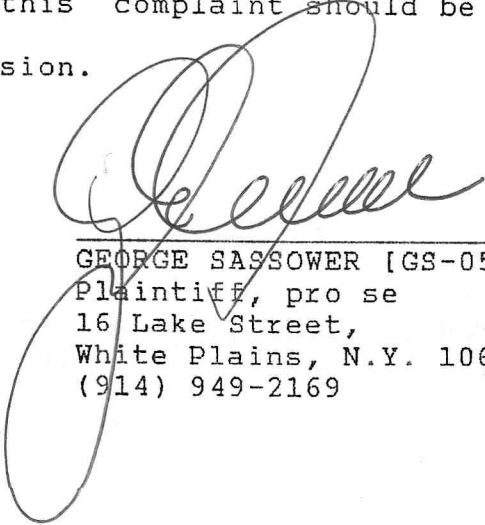
(2) In the almost five (5) years affirmant has seen no improvement, and no reason for affirmant to change his opinion on the subject.
